The registration fees indicated are the fees per participant. They include the course materials, refreshments and lunches included in the programme, as well as personal protective equipment for courses that include practical sessions. For our standard courses (excluding places reserved for the French Navy, DGAMPA-ENSAM, DGSCGC, MTECT) these prices also include accommodation and transport costs between the hotel and Cedre.

Registration on the course will be confirmed after the duly completed registration form has been received. A notification letter will be sent out one month prior to the course start date. If participants withdraw from the course less than 8 days before the course start date, 50% of the course fee will be charged.

Cedre is accredited under the French Internal Security Code (article L. 725-1, L. 725-3 and R. 725-1 to R. 725-11). The Accreditation from the French Directorate-General for Civil Protection and Crisis Management (interministerial order of 3 February 2022) officially recognises Cedre's capacity to work alongside government services in pollution response operations in French waters under the French emergency organisation ORSEC

Cedre is also accredited in accordance with articles L. 211-5-1 and R. 211-120 to R. 211 122 of the French Code of the Environment by the Ecological Transition and Territorial Cohesion and the Secretariat of State for the Sea to conduct missions of general interest providing expertise and support for the authorities including the organisation of training courses by a team of professional trainers on the management of and response to oil or chemical spills at sea, in sea ports, on the shoreline, in lakes and in watercourses. This accreditation gave rise to the ministerial order issued on 15 December 2020.

The professional training courses run by Cedre since 1985 are targeted towards technicians and managers working for industrial companies and service providers, administrations, public establishments, local authorities and associations.
